Plan Notes Key

- Flower beds at park entries
- 2. Flower beds in radial pattern offer respectful display area for markers
- 3. Curved walk contains beds and provides access to view markers
- 4. Spur on curved walk terminates at Rotary wheel and plaque behind stage
- 5. Temporary or permanent sculpture display area
- 6. Area for custom-designed shade sail over paving to meet SOI standards
- 7. Preserve and interpret Native American mound
- 8. Existing tables to be replaced with tables to match historic character of benches
- Reflecting pool to be restored

- 10. New benches with historic lannelli-style character; backless around perimeter, with backs on interior of park
- Evergreen tree removed and lawn panel restored - Fountain Complex vault below
- "Children" sculpture relocated and landscaped to reduce climbing
- Fountain Complex restored
- Temporary ice skating rink location
- New tables and chairs with historic character to match other furniture
- "Mike" the topiary peacock
- New holiday tree location
- Event display & parking pay kiosk; all parking meters removed around perimeter of park
- Tree canopy restored throughout park
