

What's Imagine Kalamazoo?



IK 2025

Community conversation

initially involving about 4,000 points of contact that shaped the **Strategic Vision & Master Plan**. IK2025 directly led to the creation of the **Foundation for Excellence** (FFE) to support the community's vision.

What made IK2025 successful was the **alignment** with

10-year plans: the Strategic Vision & the Master Plan.

5-year plans like the Parks & Recreation or Neighborhood Plans.

1-year plan: Annual budgets,Capital Improvement Plans, &Policy






